Retail Fraud Impact Panel

The Brian P. Mattson Restorative Justice Center is now offering a Retail Fraud Impact Panel. Two separate programs, one for juveniles and one for adults, are designed to inform shoplifters of the harm that their crime has caused individual retail establishments and the general community.

Participants will listen to a panel of store owners, store managers, loss prevention personal and/or community police officers describe the impact of shoplifting. Parents must attend with their child during the youth panel. Accountability of their shoplifting behavior is mandatory for all participants.

- Each panel takes place once a month.
- The panel will be held at the Muskegon County Training Center/Human Resources Building, 133 E. Apple Avenue, Room 203.
- The panel lasts approximately two hours.
- Participants are required to pay a program fee.
- We are always seeking presenters for these panels. Please contact the center directly if you or someone you know would be interested in presenting.
